

FPSM COSTS OF PARTICIPATION 2014

Registration fees and the sale of FPSP Resource Materials are two of the main means of securing income for the Program in Malaysia. Fees charged to national type and vernacular schools are always at a minimum.

Schools **may** pay an annual fee to register with the program and teach the Program to as many students as they wish. However the number of booklets, scenarios or reports that can be submitted by schools for evaluation will be determined by the number of registrations by the schools. These registrations are charged separate fees for evaluation and participation at the national competition.

FPSP Malaysia hopes that the use of e-mail and web technologies as the tool for regular communication with schools will keep Program costs to a minimum, as well as provide schools a better and more efficient service.

Registration cost can be maintained at a low level if and when financial support is forthcoming from the corporate sector. These funds will also help with the cost of training workshops in new areas within Malaysia, as well as sponsor our winning representative teams to the International Conference in USA.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM REGISTRATION

The Cost of Registration entitles:

- ◆the school to use the FPS process in the teaching of academic curriculum within a school
- ◆to purchase any FPS resource material and use it in the teaching of any FPS-based curriculum program.
- ◆Schools are required to send electronic copies/hard copies of work done using any FPS-related curriculum material to the FPSP Office for record purpose
- ◆general advice and support with the development of FPS-based curriculum
- ◆Postage, fax, telephone and photocopying cost.
